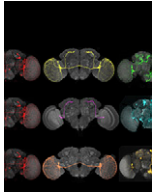


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The figure illustrates the use of the reagents described in our paper to generate cell-type-specific GAL4 lines using the split-Gal4 method. The center three brains in the center column show split-GAL4 lines for cell types involved in the circadian clock (large and small LNV cells) derived from the same AD hemidriver line (partial brain of the generation 1 GAL4 pattern shown on the left in red) combined with 3 different DBD hemidriver lines (shown in different colors on the right).
